What a relief and blessing that our community was spared from Hurricanes Harvey and Irma. We remain in the position to be a blessing to others by continuing to send relief supplies to those in need. We will be sending a second truck full of supplies to Orange, Texas. The shelter that we are supporting sent a new list of needed items including a specific types of clothing. We are working with Pastor Guillory who is connected to a network of minority communities in desperate need of aid in Orange County. These communities were struggling prior to the storm and now left with nothing. The second load of supplies is leaving September 18. We have two volunteer drivers, but need another truck and two drivers. Please let us know if you have any resources. Drop-off locations are in Destin, Niceville, Fort Walton Beach and Pensacola, FL and Baldwin County and Mobile, AL. **Thank you!**

Here is what Pastor Guillory says they need:

- **Children:** New underwear (labeled), new or like-new shoes (labeled), school uniforms: middle & high school, books/puzzles/games, NO STUFFED ANIMALS
- **Hygiene:** Toiletries, bathroom tissue, towel with wash cloth, soap, deodorant, shampoo/conditioner
- **Women:** new underwear / bras (labeled), feminine products, toiletries, adult pull-ups/diapers (i.e. Depends), new or like-new shoes (labeled)
- **Baby:** Formula, diapers, wipes, pull-ups, bottles, toiletries, baby food / cereal, utensils

- **Men:** new underwear (labeled), toiletries, razor with shaving cream, adult pull-ups/diapers (i.e. Depends), new or like-new shoes (labeled)
- **Food:** non-perishable, water, fruit drinks, fruit snacks, peanut butter and jelly, canned goods with pop-top, snacks, tuna with pop-top or in packet, utensils
- **Household:** Cleaning supplies with bucket, bleach, mask, gloves, broom, mop, dishwasher/laundry detergent, towels, cloths, first aid supplies, new or like-new bedding, new blankets, new pillows, blow-up mattress with pump
- **Volunteers / Laborers**
- **Carpet and tile** for flooded Church
